Our vinery developed 5 generations ago from the enthusiasm for wine.



Back when the first generation wasn't living solely from winemaking, they still loved this little wine village, the way of life in Rheinhessen and so they expanded the vinery. The "founder" Franz Becker, mason, renovated the significant Katharinenkirche in the neighboring village Oppenheim. His son Dr. Johann Becker, jurist, worked as a minister of finance under the grand duke Ludwig in Darmstadt and later on became delegate and minister of economy in the government of the Weimarer Republic. His brother Dr. Jakob Becker lived and worked as a doctor in Sprendlingen a village in Hessen. After the second world war the family went back to Ludwigshöhe dedicated their time exclusively to the vinery that is known under the name "Brüder Dr. Becker".
